

Job Description: **Basketball Coach – Bradford Intermediate**

Compensation: \$400 stipend for the season

Position Dates: Girls Coach: Mondays and Wednesdays, Jan 14 – Mar 13, 3:50-5:20pm

Boys Coach: Tuesdays and Thursdays, Jan 15 – Mar 14, 3:50-5:20pm

Games may run later than 5:20pm, but will be scheduled as close to after school as is possible.

Jeffco League Sports Coaches for Bradford Intermediate work under the direct supervision of Ken-Caryl Ranch Metro District's League Sports Coordinator, and additionally report to the Recreation Director. The Coaches will be employees of the Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District, and will be expected to abide by the guidelines in the District's Employee Handbook in their capacity as coach.

Responsibilities/Essential Duties:

- Coaches are *required* to attend **every** practice date and game date for Bradford Intermediate.
- Ensure the safety of all participants at all times.
- Serve as a role model for youth in a sports program focused on sportsmanship, fun, skill development and character development.
- Ensure that players all get equal play time – this is a recreational league, not a competitive league.
- Support program rules, department policies, and provide conflict resolution and behavior management when necessary.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Enjoys working with middle school aged children of all abilities.
- Coaching experience preferred but not required
- Understanding of basketball rules and regulations
- Teaches basketball rules and regulations as appropriate to Jeffco League Sports
- Connection to Bradford Intermediate preferred but not required
- CPR/First Aid certification preferred but not required
- Qualified candidates will be required to pass a background check
- Qualified candidates will be required to complete concussion training at no cost to candidate
