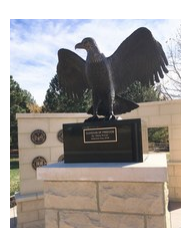
Election Ends Nov. 6

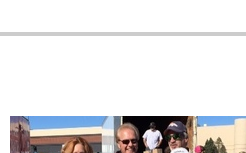
