Fire Restrictions Implemented in Jefferson County



As of June 5, Jefferson County Sheriff Jeff Shrader implemented temporary Stage 1 Fire Restrictions for all lands in Jefferson County.

These restrictions are being enacted due to current dry conditions favorable for the possibility of a wildfire and limited availability of fire control resources. **The use of all fireworks is prohibited within the restricted area.** Citizens wishing to obtain current fire restriction or fire ban information, firework regulations, burn permit information, or to report a firework violation can call the Jeffco Sheriff's Fire Information Hotline at 303-271-8200. 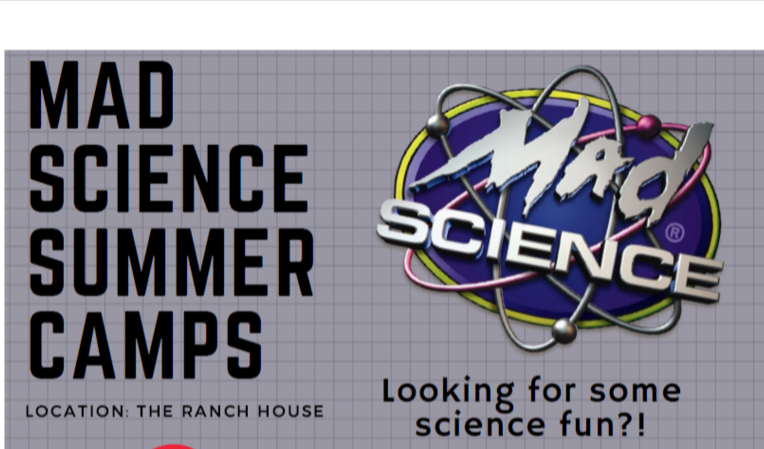

RTD Proposing Bus Route 85 Elimination

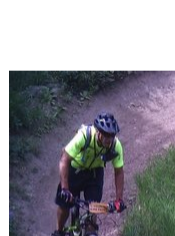

- There are 26 volunteer patrollers and each will be wearing a blue vest with a KCR Volunteer Patrol patch and identification.

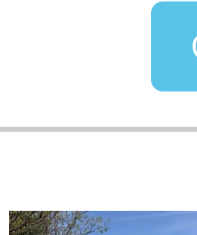
Lacrosse Camp
