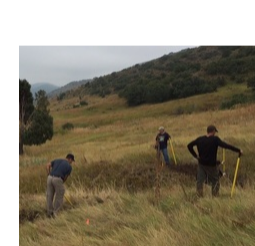


Transportation Study Completed for C-470

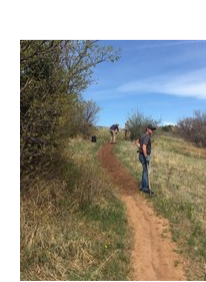
RTD News: Route 85 Update and Fare Proposal Open House

Route 85 bus service on Continental Divide and Chatfield Ave. will discontinue in August but will be replaced with a Call-n-Ride Flexline in August. The Flexline will operate virtually identically to the Route 85, using the exact same routing, stops and times. The primary change is that the bus will be a standard green Call-n-Ride bus. Route 85 riders can continue to use the same stops when the Call-n-Ride Flex Line service begins.

Also, the RTD Board is hosting an open house on Monday, July 23 from 6:30-8 p.m. at Columbine Library to discuss fare proposals and pass program working group recommendations.
