KCRMD Board Votes to Place Mill Levy on November Ballot



At the Aug. 21 Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District Board Meeting, the Board voted to place a mill levy ballot initiative on the November 2018 ballot. The Board is seeking voter approval to increase its mill levy by 8 mills in order to continue offering services at current levels, increase services where needed, create operational and capital reserves, and offset the impacts of the Gallagher Amendment. 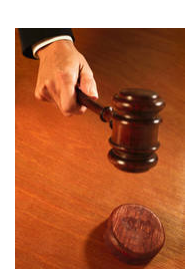
Community Trash Event

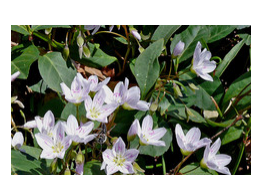
