## Christmas Tree Chipping at Brannon Gearhart Park

The Parks Department will continue to accept Christmas trees for chipping at Brannon Gearhart Park through Jan. 19. Brannon Gearhart Park is

located just east of Valley Parkway between Mahonia and Buckthorn. Be sure to remove any non-coniferous items such as metallic materials and tinsel before bringing your trees as many materials can damage the chipping equipment. The mulch will be applied at the base of trees and shrubs in parks and greenbelts.

## Trash Can Placement



To help ensure quick and easy trash pick-up, Waste Connections requests that residents place trash cans on the street side of the curb in the gutter. If you do not have a sidewalk, cans should be placed in the valley pan, or area between your property and the street. Cans should not be left for pick up in driveways, by garages, or block public walkways. Improperly placed cans could result in trash not being picked up or cause delays in the pickup route.

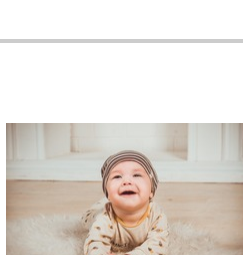

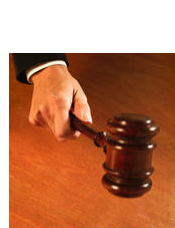
