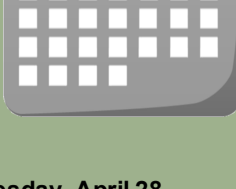

Jefferson County has extended its current Stay-At-Home Order through May 8. For Metro District and Master Association purposes, this includes the recommendation for the general population to stay at home except when absolutely necessary. To date, there has been no official comment regarding summer camps, parks, and recreation facilities; therefore, there is still a great deal of confusion and uncertainty around the community's programs and facilities.

We will be spending the next several weeks gathering information from the CDC, Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, and neighboring agencies to ensure consistency in practice and policy so as to not create unnecessary burden or an unintended attractive nuisance. 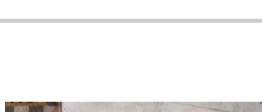
**Jeffco Public Library Offers Online Story Time**

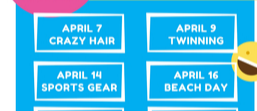
