

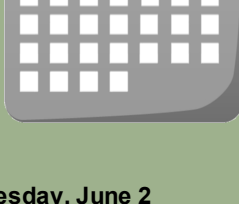

Pool Reopening Update and Resident Aquatic Survey Results

The Metropolitan District Board of Directors met for its regular monthly meeting on May 26. At that meeting, the Board reviewed aquatic survey results from over 1,300 residents regarding the future of aquatic facilities.

All aquatic facilities are governed by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and Jefferson County Public Health. Currently, pools are not permitted to be open and these agencies have not released a timeline for reopening pools; however, the District eagerly awaits more information from the state and local agencies.

If pools are allowed to be reopened and enough staff has been secured to be able to manage the facilities, the Community Center Pool will be reopening as soon as possible followed by the Ranch House Pool, which is set to be completed sometime in mid-July. Once approval is received, it will still take two weeks or more to train staff and prepare the facilities. There will be restrictions for use, required online registration and payment for time slots, and a per person daily fee for use. Staff is working to develop plans for reopening and fee structures.

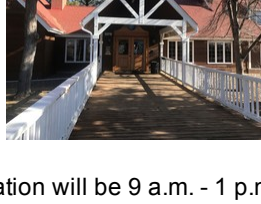

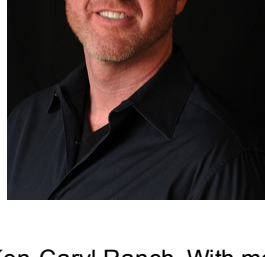
Ranch House Opens with Limited Hours

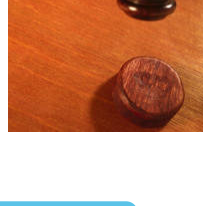
Small group fitness and personal training sessions are now available following the lifting of Stay-at-Home Orders.
