## Tin Cup Fire Action



An unauthorized fire at the Tin Cup campsite was reported and found to be smoldering on the morning of Aug. 10. When investigated by the KCRMA Rangers, it was determined that the fire was still hot and there was broken glass, cans and rocks in the fire. The picnic table was also moved from its original site to the campsite.

Seven youth in the community were identified to be involved with the incident. The Ken-Caryl Ranch Master Association Board has fined each of the households involved \$150 as well as 12 hours of community service. Ken-Caryl Ranch is fortunate the fire did not spread and potentially burn our homes, damage property, impact our Open Space, cause evacuations and the like. The Board takes fire danger very seriously and hopes everyone involved understands the danger of the situation.
