## SPECIFIC DUTIES

- Control noxious and other invasive weeds utilizing integrated weed management techniques including mapping, monitoring, mowing, trimming, and pulling. Also mixing, loading, and applying herbicides using motorized and/or hand-held equipment.
- Operate, maintain, and perform minor repairs on equipment and vehicles, such as mowers, trucks, sprayers, weed whips, chainsaws, etc.
- Utilize software to map and monitor populations of weeds. Follow requirements and regulations of local, county, state, and federal weed control programs, including all requirements relevant to pesticide storage, mixing, application, and disposal.
- Provide as-needed notification to at-risk residents prior to pesticide application.
- Record and maintain appropriate records and reports.
- Perform Forest Management.

## EXPERIENCE

Working knowledge of equipment and natural resource management is desired.

## SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Natural Resource Technicians will be subject to hot and cold working conditions outdoors, physically strenuous work, working with chemical pesticides and working with power equipment.

A candidate needs a positive attitude; good communication skills, be self-motivated; possess strong attention to detail and have an ability to work independently. Must be able to work in all-weather elements.
