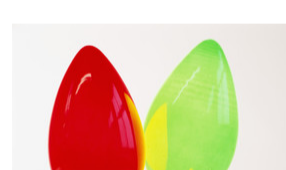

## Reminder to Take Down Holiday Lights

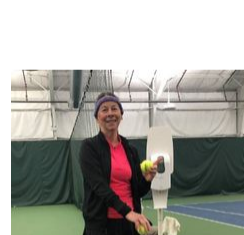
As tempting as it is to want to hold onto the spirit of the holidays, all residents are kindly reminded to please take down, and not just turn off, their holiday
