Here's how the election works:

- All residents will need a voting code to vote.
- Residents and businesses will have received either an email or a mailed postcard, if they don't have an email in our system, with their voting code and instructions on or after Feb. 10.

- Residents are eligible to vote for up to two candidates.
- The election will close online Tuesday, March 2 at 5 p.m. and results will be posted at www.ken-carylranh.org later that night.

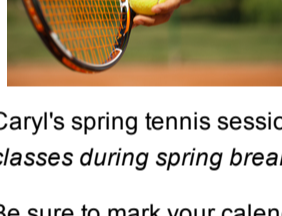
Ken-Caryl Ranch Foundation Scholarships

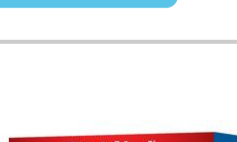

Pre-registration Required to Access the Fitness Center
