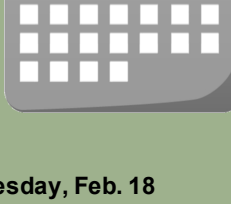

Don't Forget to Vote in the Master Association Board Election!

- The Ken-Caryl Ranch Master Association Board election began Feb. 12 and runs through March 3 at 5 p.m.
- Residents and businesses with an email address in our accounting system should have received an email from kcr@ivotehoa.com on Feb. 12 with voting instructions.
- Those residents and businesses without an email in the system were mailed a beige postcard last week.
- There is one ballot per household or business. If you own multiple properties or are a business, you will only vote once, but your vote will be weighted.
- The election is online, but paper ballots are available at the Ranch House Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., or by appointment, for those residents who do not wish to vote online. You will need a photo ID to vote with a paper ballot.

New Series of One-Day Painting Workshops!

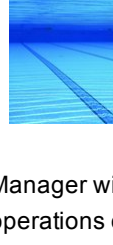

Master Association Annual Meeting: Proxies Needed!

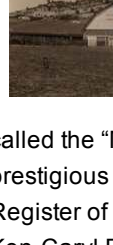
