

To protect the safety of our Waste Connections drivers, the following changes to our trash service are currently in place:

Waste Connections: Trash Pick-up Safety

· All large cardboard must be cut and placed inside a recycling container, trash container or garbage bag. No boxes can be set on the curb. • Household trash will be limited to one filled can (either

three bags on the side.) If you have yard waste it must be either in your trash can or in the three extra bags. Recycling service will be normal, and they will pick up any recycling inside your regular containers. No extra boxes will be picked up from the curb. No bulk items may be placed out, such as mattresses, furniture, etc. This will ensure efficient operations and
