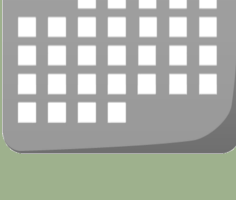

MD Board Election Update

Residents should receive their mail-in ballots for the MD Election by today, Monday, April 20. You may return your ballot by mail (don't forget to include adequate postage), or you may now drop off your ballot safely using the mail slot located by the Ranch House main entrance doors.

- Ballots must be received by the Designated Election Official by 7 p.m. on Election Day, May 5, in order for your vote(s) to be counted.
- Ballots received after 7 p.m. on Election Day will not be counted.
- Postmarks do not count as a received date.
- Residents may request a Replacement Ballot by contacting the Designated Election Official during regular business hours, or from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. on Election Day.

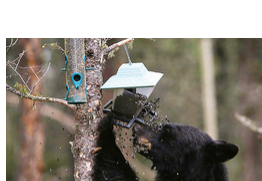
