Pool Cues: No Reservations Required! All Three Pools to Open!

We are excited to announce that all three pools will be open this summer! Under the current COVID guidelines for summer, no reservations will be required. Families can swim when they like, as often as they like! Residents can choose between purchasing a Resident Pool Pass, good for the entire season, or daily use fees. The Resident Pool Pass is \$35 per person for pool access for the entire summer! Daily use fees will be \$5 for District residents and \$8 for Non-District residents. Pool passes are for ages 3+. Children under 3 are free.

COVID-19 Updates:



Jefferson County Public Health issued a public health order, PHO 21-001, to help guide the county through the recovery phase of the COVID-19 pandemic and into a full reopening. Under the new order, there are two phases to reopening:

April 16 - May 15: Level Blue with capacity limits based on activity or facility.

May 16 - August 15: Level Clear will include no restrictions. Businesses will operate at 100 percent capacity with no mitigation requirements, although indoor mask requirements may still apply. Level Clear will remain in effect so long as hospitalization rates remains below two per 100,000 population over a 14-day period.

*Certain programs such as childcare operations may have more stringent policies due to certification requirements.

Note: If hospitalization rates rise above the mandated limit, the District may be required to modify capacity limits or registration processes, and may be required to enact social distancing measures and program/facility modifications. If program cancellations are necessary, credits for future program registrations will be applied to customer accounts.

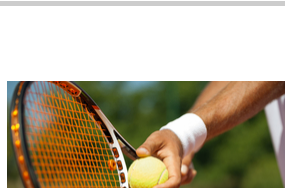

adults and juniors.

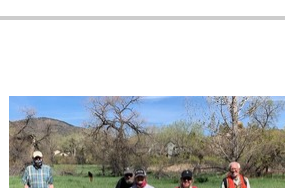

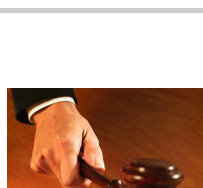
