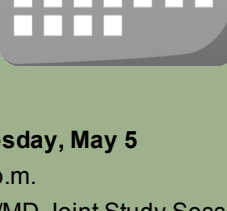

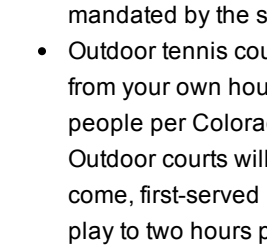
Ken-Caryl Celebrates Memorial Day

Safer-at-Home Update

The following changes to facilities and programs will be implemented ONLY WHEN Jefferson County has lifted the current Stay-at-Home Order. **As this is a rapidly evolving situation, this may change as more information becomes available and residents are reminded that Ken-Caryl is subject to follow Jefferson County's public safety guidelines as they are issued.** We appreciate your patience as we carefully re-open programs and facilities and strive to keep our community safe.

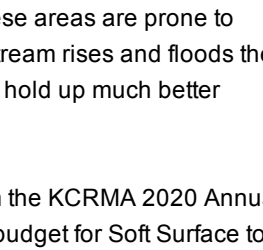
Safer-at-Home Updates that may take place as early as May 9 are below. These updates will ONLY occur when the Stay-at-Home Order has been lifted for Jefferson County:

- All playgrounds and picnic areas will remain closed as mandated by the state of Colorado.
- Outdoor tennis courts can only be used with people from your own household and only with less than four people per Colorado Safer-at-Home guidelines. Outdoor courts will be available to residents on a first-come, first-served basis. We ask all families to limit play to two hours per day.
- The Disc Golf course will be open. Social distancing is required.
- Personal training will be available at the Community Center. More information on personal training sessions is available on our website.
- Summer camps are scheduled to open on June 8 with significant modifications. Registered camp families will receive additional information via email. All Teen Camps for Summer 2020 are cancelled.
- We are waiting for additional guidance to make decisions regarding swimming pools. More information will be posted as soon as it is available.
- Equestrian Center summer camps may run as scheduled with modifications to meet CDC guidelines. Private and semi-private lessons will resume in the summer.
- Ranch House offices will remain closed until later in May.
- The Dakota Lodge and Community Center will remain closed to the general public.
- Facility, pavilion and park rentals will not be available during the month of May.

MD Election Ballots Due May 5

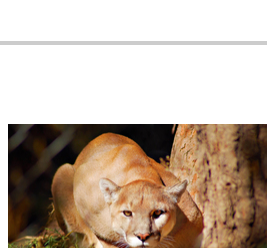


Just a reminder to submit your ballots for the three open seats on the MD Board! All ballots were sent to residents by mail and must be received by the Designated Election Official by 7 p.m. on Election Day, tomorrow, May 5.

There's still time to submit your ballot! Postmark dates will not suffice, and all ballots MUST be received by tomorrow's deadline. Therefore, ballots may also be dropped off at the Ranch House, safely through the secured mailbox located next to the main entrance doors of the Ranch House.

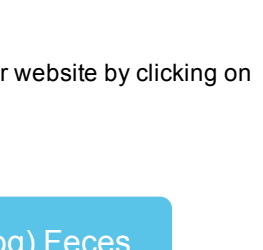
Purple Ash Trail Improvements

The Ken-Caryl Ranch Open Space Committee will review planned improvements to the Purple Ash Trail at their monthly meeting on May 27. The current trail tread is a combination of crusher fine and concrete surfaces. The plan is to replace two, 50' sections of crusher fine tread on either side of the stream crossing with colored concrete. These areas are prone to wash out during storms when the stream rises and floods the trail. The hardened trail surface will hold up much better during these storm events.

Funds for the project will come from the KCRMA 2020 Annual Plan under the One-Time Projects budget for Soft Surface to Hard Surface Trail Conversions. There are several locations in open space where these conversions have occurred and staff believes it is a good option for addressing reoccurring maintenance problems with sections of soft surface trails that were either built on too steep a slope or experience concentrated storm flows.

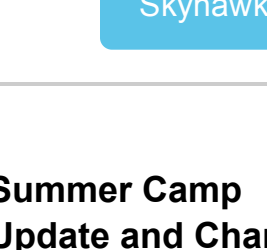
Community Garage Sale Event Cancelled

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to keep our community safe!



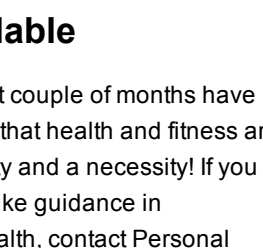
Mountain Lion Sightings in the Valley

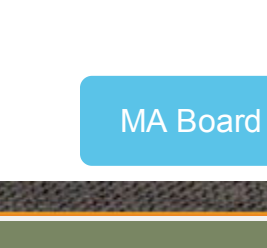
Here is the scoop regarding poop:
