tennis and fitness facilities. The District is working toward preparing the Community Center Pool for opening, followed by the Ranch House Pool.

There is a great deal of work to do to train staff and prepare the facility, so the Community Center opening date is anticipated sometime later in June. Construction on the Ranch House Pool will likely not be completed until July. Additionally, guidance has been received regarding the opening of parks and playgrounds. The new State Order

includes the reopening of playgrounds for up to 10 people at a time, so playgrounds will include signage indicating as such. Users are strongly encouraged to bring hand sanitizer and wipes for their own personal use of the playground. The State Order also includes the relaxation of restriction for use of parks. Outdoor facilities such as tennis courts,

basketball courts and fields may be used by up to 25 people at a time per court/field. All permits for use take precedence

over drop-in use. Please email info@kcranch.org to obtain
