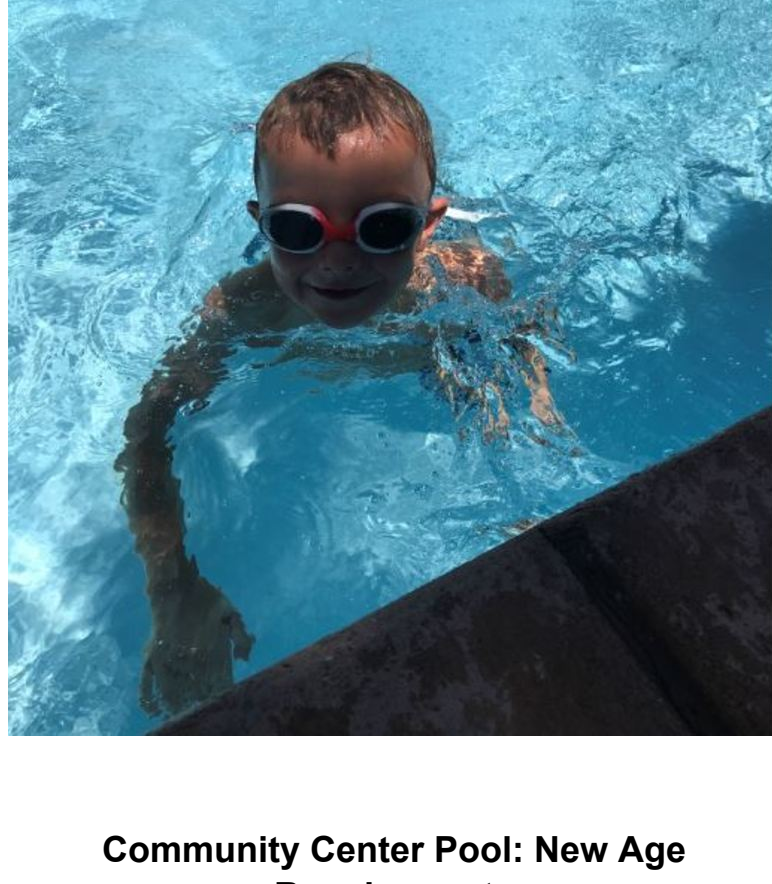

Community Center Pool: New Age Requirements

The learning process continues for pool regulations as we have encountered many issues with enforcement of the age restrictions. Originally, anyone 12 and under had to be accompanied by someone 18 or older. We realize that many families use responsible babysitters and other family members to provide supervision while at the pool, so the NEW regulation will be as follows:

Anyone 12 and under must be accompanied by a responsible party, age 13 or older.

Current Commercial Vehicle Rule in Place

Earlier this year, the Architectural Committee proposed a change to the current Commercial Vehicles Rule to allow these types of vehicles to be parked in resident driveways. However, many residents expressed concerns about the proposed rule change. After further discussion, the Committee voted and decided to keep the current Commercial Vehicle rule in place. Therefore, all commercial vehicles must be kept in a garage or stored offsite.

Residents are also reminded that all types of recreation vehicles, including, but not limited to, RVs, boats or trailers can only be parked in resident driveways or on neighborhood streets for a maximum of two consecutive days during a seven-day period and must be stored offsite or in your garage.
