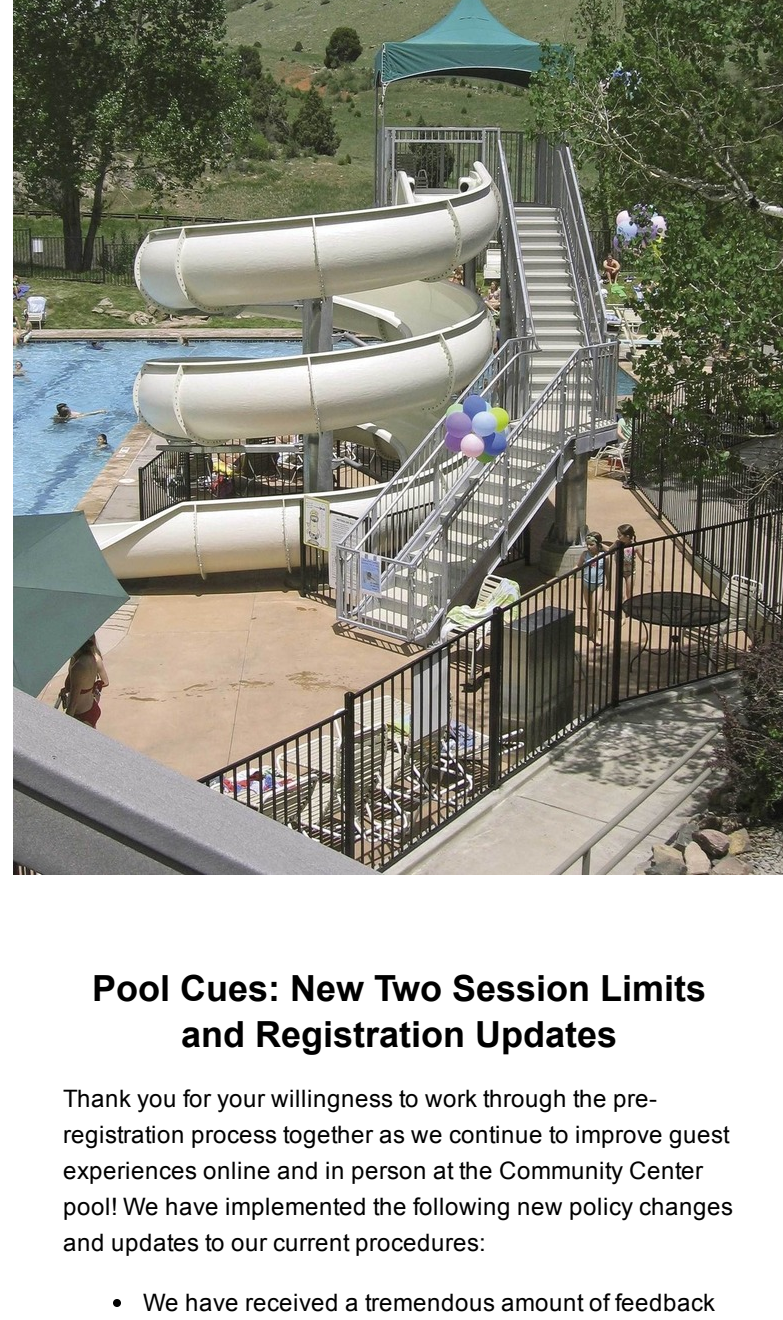

## Pool Cues: New Two Session Limits and Registration Updates

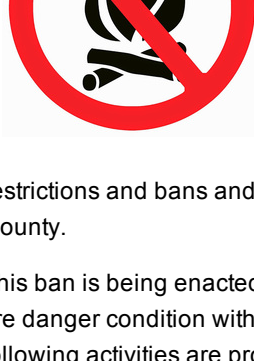
Thank you for your willingness to work through the pre-registration process together as we continue to improve guest experiences online and in person at the Community Center pool! We have implemented the following new policy changes and updates to our current procedures:

- We have received a tremendous amount of feedback that there is more demand than available spots. To better serve more people from the community, please limit your household registrations to **two sessions** per week to allow for others to enjoy the pool. **Please only sign up for two time slots per week and only one time slot per day.** That is: two time slots per individual/family per week.
- Policy offenders who register for more than two slots are being notified and additional reservations cancelled.
- To ensure a more efficient and faster registration process, residents can simply create a reservation under one account holder's name and select the number of desired "seats", up to eight seats total, similar to that of a restaurant reservation, as opposed to registering each individual separately. For instructions, please refer to our pre-registration tutorial below.
- Residents who were unable to secure a registration are encouraged to check back on our website to see if slots have opened up due to cancellations.
- The slide and diving board are not open for the 7-9 a.m. session. They will open at the 9:15 a.m. sessions. The diving board is closed for the first 30 minutes of all sessions starting at 9:15 a.m. for open swim and will remain open the remainder of those sessions.
- As tempting as it may be, **please do not give away or sell your session!** In the unfortunate event of a COVID-19 outbreak, we must produce an accurate roster of every person responsible for registration, which is turned over to Jefferson County Public Health and the State of Colorado for notification and tracking purposes. **Giving your session away means you are responsible for all individuals you have given your sessions to!** Please cancel your reservation within 24-hours to open up these reserved seats.

## Jeffco Issues Stage 2 Fire Ban

Jefferson County Sheriff Jeff Shrader has enacted a Stage 2 Fire Ban for Jefferson County. This temporary Stage 2 Fire Ban supersedes all previous fire restrictions and bans and applies to all lands in Jefferson County.

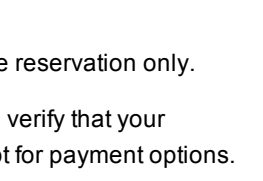
This ban is being enacted due to the continuing high fire danger condition within Jefferson County. As a result, the following activities are prohibited pursuant to a Stage 2 fire ban:

- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area of at least six feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all combustible material.
- Building, maintaining, attending or using any fire.
- Recreational fires, including recreational campfires.
- Open burning including "bon fires" that require a permit from the fire authority having jurisdiction.
- The USE of ALL fireworks.
- Chain saws shall only be operated with a USDA or SAE approved spark arresting device properly installed and in proper working order.
- Welding and cutting torch appliances shall only be operated within an area that is barren or cleared of all combustible material at least 30 feet in all directions from the operating equipment.
- Use of an explosive initiation system requiring a burning fuse line.

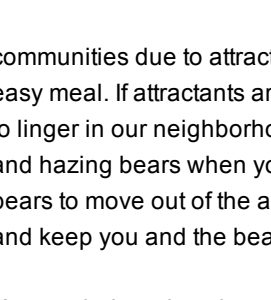

## Bears Make Bad Neighbors

Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW) has received calls about bear activity in our area. We live in prime bear habitat and these intelligent bruins can be lured into communities due to attractants and the prospect of a free and easy meal. If attractants are not removed, bears will continue to linger in our neighborhood. Removing these attractants, and hazing our bears when you see them, can help encourage bears to move out of the area on their own, reduce conflicts and keep you and the bears safe.

You can help reduce bear conflicts by adhering to the following:

- ONLY place your trash in a locked garage or outbuilding & ONLY place your trash outside on the morning of collection.
- Take down all birdfeeders (hummingbird, suet and seed) until Thanksgiving (including those on upper levels).
- Keep cars locked and do not leave anything with a scent in your vehicle.
- Keep garage doors closed and lock all lower level doors & windows, especially at night.
- Feed pets inside.

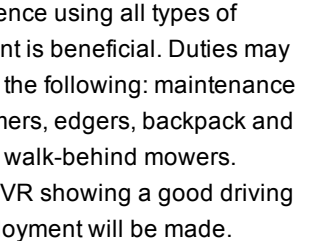
If you see a bear, haze it away to help keep it from becoming habituated to people. This can include yelling at it, banging pots and pans together, honking your car horn, activating the alarm on your vehicle, using an air horn, etc.

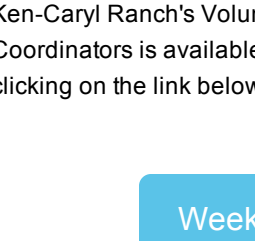
Looking for a fun and dynamic job opportunity? Then look no further! The MD is hiring!

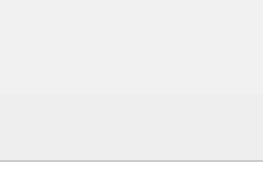
