household, with the following exception: if a 7-9 a.m. time slot is not full the day before you wish to attend, you may sign up. However, reservations are not to exceed a total of four time slots per week. Those found abusing this policy will be subject to reservation withdrawal. Please note that per Jefferson County's Mask Order, masks are required for wear except when in the water or in




