Pool Cues: Reservation Information and Updates

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate state and county rules and regulations regarding COVID-19 prevention efforts.

Residents are reminded to only register for two time slots at the Community Center pool per week, one per day per household, with the following exception: if a 7-9 a.m. time slot is not full the day before you wish to attend, you may sign up. However, reservations are not to exceed a total of four time slots per week. Those found abusing this policy will be subject to reservation withdrawal.

Please note that per Jefferson County's Mask Order, masks are required for wear except when in the water or in your designated sitting area and six feet away from those not in your household. Lifeguards will wear masks when they are not on stand.

On July 24, Jefferson County issued a mandatory Mask Order, which requires residents and visitors to wear a face covering while in indoor **and** outdoor public settings.

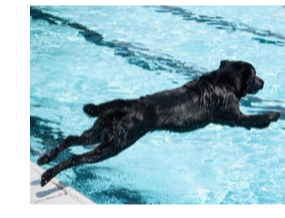


Individuals who do not have to wear a mask include:

Please be Advised of Increased Bear Activity

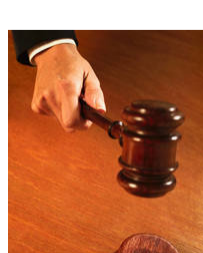
Due to increased bear activity in our area, the Rangers are recommending that residents delay putting out their trash cans until the morning of their scheduled trash pick-up.
