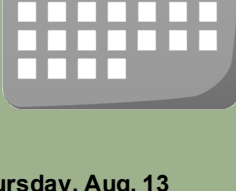

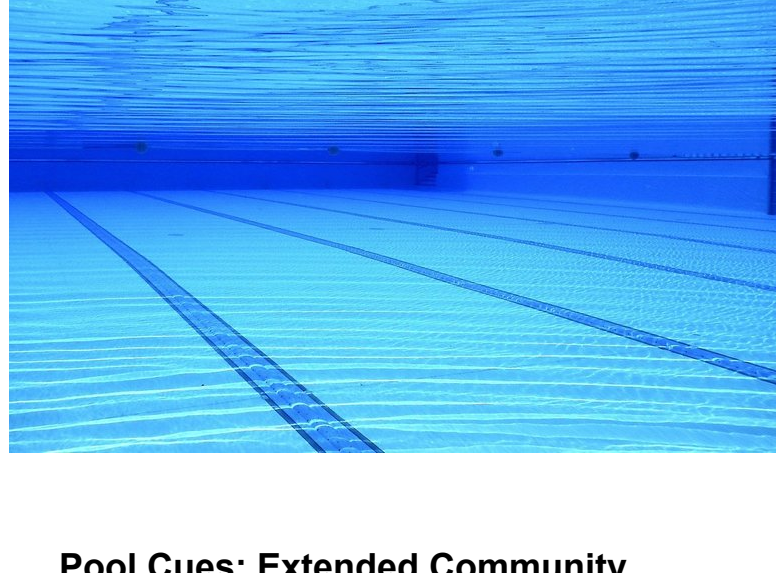

## Pool Cues: Extended Community Center Pool Hours

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate state and county rules and regulations regarding COVID-19 prevention efforts.

Good news for this week's Pool Cues! Don't pack away those summer swim suits just yet! Community Center summer pool hours will continue through Aug. 23 as a result of the delayed school start date. Beginning Aug. 24, pool hours will be reduced to 4-6 p.m. swim sessions during the weekdays and from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m. on weekends to accommodate back-to-school lifeguard schedules and to maintain the staff necessary to safely conduct pool operations.

**Please note that per Jefferson County's Mask Order, masks are required for wear except when in the water or in your designated sitting area and six feet away from those not in your household. Lifeguards will wear masks when they are not on stand.**

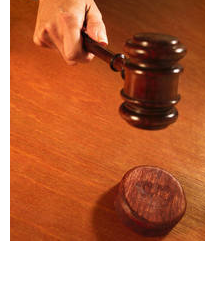

## Register for your Open Space ID Bracelets Online!



Did you know that you can quickly and easily register for your Open Space orange ID bracelets on our website? Just click on the button below for details and to access the online registration form. Once approved, you will be notified when your bracelets are available for pick-up at the Ranch House between 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. Mondays through Thursdays.

Trail users with a visible ID bracelet do not need to be stopped by Rangers or Volunteer Patrollers. There is no cost. Two bracelets will be issued per household and can be temporarily transferred to house guests.

If you already have orange Open Space Bracelets from 2019 or 2020, you do NOT need new bracelets. Bracelets are good for three years until Dec. 2021.
