Current Signage Rule to Remain in **Effect**

After soliciting community

feedback via the newspaper, e-News and Facebook on the Temporary Signage Posting Rules, and the request for approval to post

signs reflecting current social issues, it was voted to keep the Temporary Signage Posting Rules as they currently stand. In fact, 91.5 percent of the feedback received from the community was to keep the current Temporary Signage Posting Rules as they are, with 8.5 percent of feedback received to change the rules as written. The current rule states that no sign of any kind shall be

displayed to the public view without the approval of the Architectural Committee. The purpose of the rule is to avoid clutter, maintain uniformity and create harmony throughout the community public spaces of Ken-Caryl Ranch. The Committee will be reviewing and updating the rules to

include home security signs, no soliciting signs, invisible

fence, decorative signs, safety signs and no trespassing signs and will develop parameters surrounding the posting of said signs, such as placement, aesthetic and size restrictions. Additionally, residents will have another opportunity to address this rule in the 2021 Resident Survey. We will be




