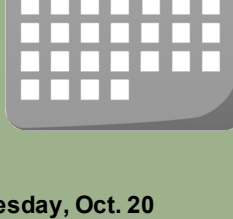

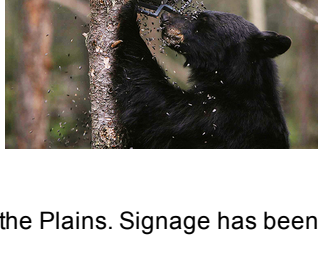

Please Be Bear Aware!

Bears have been positively identified in the Plains! As a result, the KCRMA Rangers will be increasing education efforts with the addition of new bear awareness signs in the Plains. Signage has been posted in the Valley.



Did you know that once rewarded, it could take up to 20 times to deter that same bear from a food source? If that food source is your bird feeder or trash, you can expect a routine visitor. This time of year, bears are on the hunt to pack on 20,000 calories a day. A fed bear is a dead bear, so let's protect these bruins. Here's how:

- 1.) Secure all trash and don't put trash out the evening prior to pick up.
- 2.) Remove ALL attractants, including bird feeders, dog food and pick up/discard fallen fruit from trees.
- 3.) Secure car doors and remove anything that emits a scent including food, wrappers, bags, even scented wipes.
- 4.) Close all garage doors, especially at night.
- 5.) If you see a bear in your yard, haze it. Activate the car alarm, honk your horn, yell from a window, use an airhorn, etc.

* While these bruins are breathtaking, they also pose a danger to residents. As a result, all residents are reminded to maintain a safe distance from area wildlife, including bears.

Youth (7-17 years) – Resident: \$15, Non-Resident: \$17

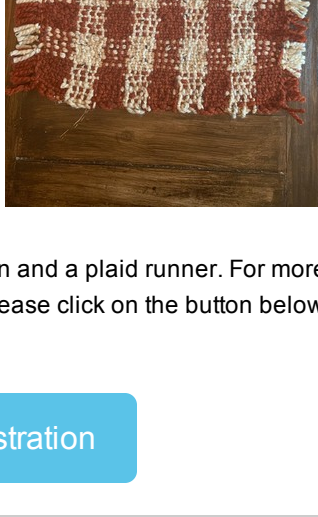

Pumpkins and Plaid Knitting Class!

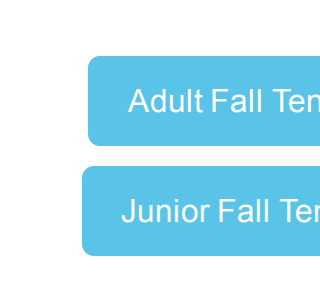

For the "love"... of tennis! Registration for Junior and Adult Fall Tennis is open!

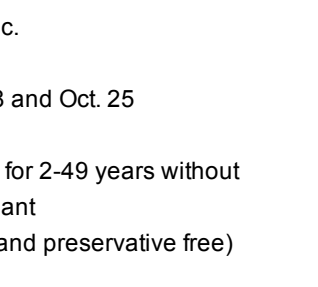
All registration will be online – on a first-come, first "served" basis. There will not be a lottery.

The Colorado Flu Shot Company will be offering drive-up family flu vaccinations at the Ken-Caryl Community Center parking circle. The flu shot is recommended for anyone six months or older.

Flu vaccinations are highly recommended this year by the CDC during the COVID-19 pandemic. Some complications from influenza include bronchitis, pneumonia and strep and influenza can make people more vulnerable to fight other infections such as COVID-19.

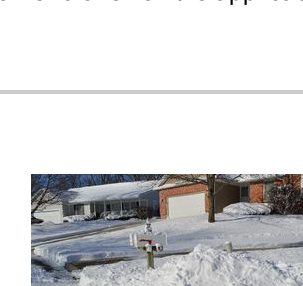
Masks are required at the clinic.

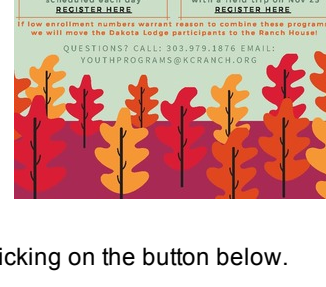
Driveway Snow Removal
