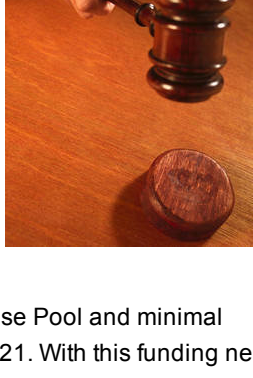

**Master Association Board Draft Budget Online**

An updated 2021 Draft Budget for the Ken-Caryl Ranch Master Association is now online at the link below. The current budget draft proposes keeping the same dues level as 2020. A large portion of the 2020 budget included funding for the Ranch House Pool and minimal funding is needed for the pool in 2021. With this funding need behind us, the Board will be able to fund some operational increases as well as several one-time projects in 2021 without raising community dues. The Board is planning to vote on the budget at the Oct. 20 meeting at 6 p.m. at the Ranch House.

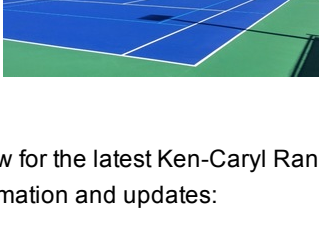
Beginning Nov. 2, the Fitness Facility at the Community Center will be open during the following hours:

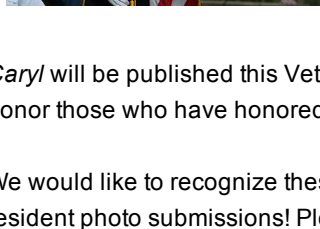
Flu vaccinations are highly recommended this year by the CDC during the COVID-19 pandemic. Some complications from influenza include bronchitis, pneumonia and strep and influenza can make people more vulnerable to fight other infections such as COVID-19.

Masks are required at the clinic.

**Cost:** Flu shot: \$40  
FluMist: \$40 Intranasal for 2-49 years without chronic illness or pregnant (Both are quadrivalent and preservative free)

**Payment:** Cash, check or credit card accepted. Receipts available for possible insurance reimbursement. CFSC does not bill insurance directly.

**Pod Learning Opportunities!**

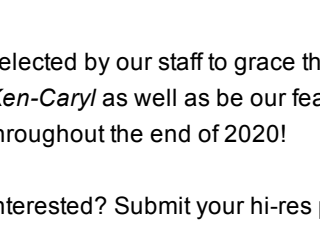

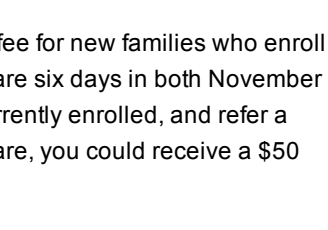


**Seasons of Ken-Caryl Winter Photo Contest**

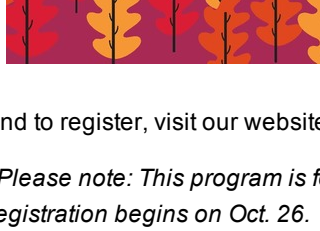
**Shaffer Elementary B&A Care!**
