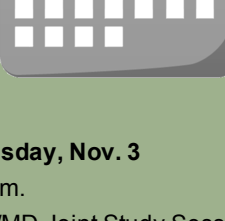

The Metropolitan District discussed the 2021 draft budget at the Oct. 27 Board meeting. The budget process includes two more meetings on Nov. 10 and Dec. 1. Both meetings include a public hearing component where the community is invited to share feedback. 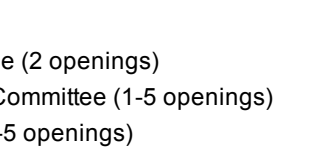

While we all focus on maintaining our properties and our community, Community Administrator Brian Yowell shares some information on how to get street lights repaired that are broken, burnt out, or damaged.

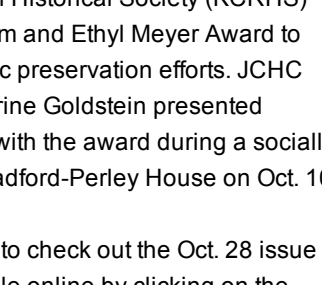

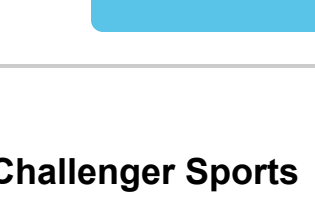
**KCRHS Awarded the Norm and Ethyl Meyer Award**

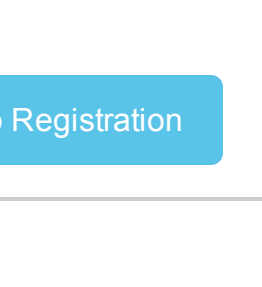
**New Fitness Center Hours**

**Challenger Sports Offers Thanksgiving Camp**

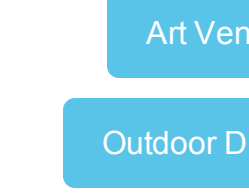

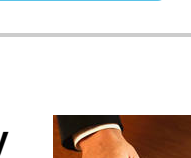


**Only One Honor Brick Remains!**

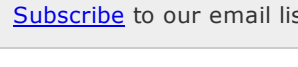
**Pickleball "Returns" to the Court**
