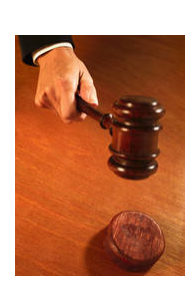

Holiday Survival Dance Classes

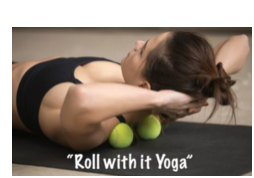
