Wildfire Hazard Mitigation Plan Update



Updates to the Ken-Caryl Ranch Wildfire Hazard Mitigation Plan were prepared by the Colorado State Forest Service with input from Open Space Staff, the Firewise Committee, and West Metro Fire. The Master Association Board will review and vote on the proposed changes at its May 21 meeting at 6 p.m. at the Ranch House. The updated plan places more emphasis on residents creating defensible space around their homes in case of a wildfire. The home ignition zone has been added to include the home itself as well as the hazards around the home. The plan also includes the 10-foot expanded mowing buffer into open space. Residents living adjacent to open space are encouraged to mow and maintain the buffer. 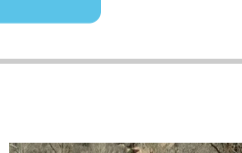

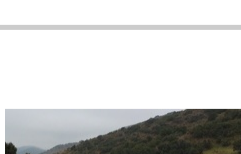
