Fire Ban in Effect

On June 28, Sheriff Jeff Shrader implemented a temporary Stage 2 Fire Ban for all lands in Jefferson County. Prohibited items include but are not limited to:



- Fireworks
- Charcoal Grills
- Fire Pits and Chimineas (gas-fueled allowed)
- Tiki Torches

Ken-Caryl Mastodon Mandible on Display

A cast of a rare mastodon mandible found on Ken-Caryl Ranch in 2009 is on display at the Ranch House.

On June 1, 2009 KCR residents Jake Carstensen, then 12 years old, and Tyler Kellett, 13, discovered a partial lower jaw and tusk fragments of an American Mastodon near the Community Center. In September of that year scientists from the Denver Museum of Nature and Science (DMNS) explored the area and excavated a five-foot segment of a seven-inch diameter tusk. The actual specimen is preserved and stored at the DMNS, but the cast of the mandible on display was provided courtesy of the DMNS to recognize the discovery.

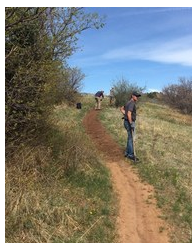
