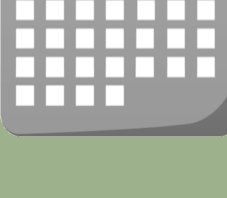

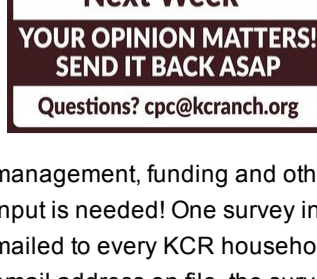

## Make Your Voice Heard!

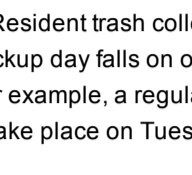
Ken-Caryl Ranch is conducting a community survey to get your opinions on amenities, open space

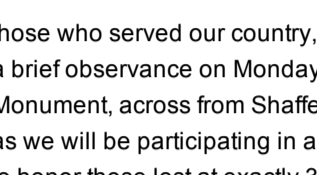

There is some confusion regarding parking at the Manor House now that there

is a gate at the entrance. The gate will automatically open when a car approaches between the hours of 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. daily. ## Community Park Playground Closure Due to Damage

Over the course of the last several weeks, Community Park

has experienced a tremendous amount of damage. There were approximately 60 large landscape rocks scattered on the playground features and throughout the turf areas. Some of those same rocks were being smashed on the top of the new rock wall that separates the playground from the landscape bed. There were numerous broken tree branches. Lastly, and most impactful, was the damage to the playground safety surfacing. This is the surfacing that protects kids from injury if in the event of a fall, so it serves a critical purpose. With enough effort and time, someone could remove it in chunks as you can see from the picture. That happened to such a large extent over the last two weekends, we are closing the entire playground to conduct repairs starting May 25. The repaired surfacing requires time to cure, so it will be closed through at least Thursday of this week. Stay tuned for a complete closure as the entire surface is replaced sometime this summer.

## Raising the Barre on Fitness!



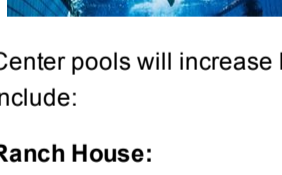
A new four-week session of Barre Above class begins June 4. The class meets on Fridays

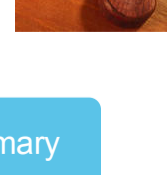

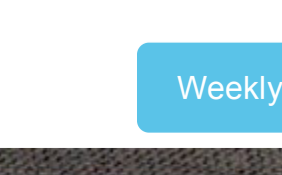
