## Community Survey Closes Fri., 6/18

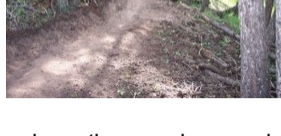
Make your voice heard regarding amenities, open space management, funding and other community matters. All residents should have received either an email or postcard with an invitation and unique code to complete the survey.

For 2021, the Open Space Committee is running a trial program on three single track trails where the mowing would be discontinued, to see if not mowing the trails leads to less trail widening. The trails included in this trial program are Massey Draw Trail, from Valley Parkway to Colorow Trail, Lark Bunting Trail, eastern portion and Manor House Connector Trail.

Flick 'n Float Dive-In Movies at the Ranch House, generously sponsored by our friends at Colorado Credit Union, are back! Mark your calendars:

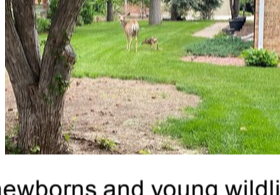
**Sunday, June 20 – Moana**

## Haaay! Calling All Equestrian Center Camp Volunteers!



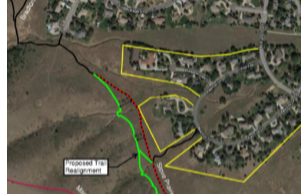
The Ken-Caryl Equestrian Center is looking for volunteers ages 13+ with horse experience to assist with summer camps.

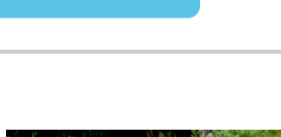
## Stove Prairie Trail Re-alignment

## Be Bear Aware!



Recently, a resident and their friend were cooking breakfast at the Silver Cliff camp site. A bear wandered into the campsite, consumed the food, rummaged through packs consuming snacks, and tore and damaged the tent. Fortunately, the campers were unharmed and retreated to a safe distance.

Here are a few safety tips:

**Stash Your Trash.** Use bear-proof containers or use a bag to hang your food/scented items high into a tree away from the camp site using a rope.

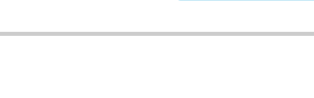
**Store Attractants Safely.** Store food, beverages and toiletries in air tight containers.

**Keep a Clean Camp.** Bears are attracted to odors of all kinds and will investigate anything interesting in hopes of finding food. Cook away from your tent site.

**Keep a Clean Tent.** Don't bring anything with an odor into your tent – that includes all foods, beverages, scented toiletries, gum, toothpaste, sunscreen, candles and insect repellent. Don't sleep in the clothes you cooked in.

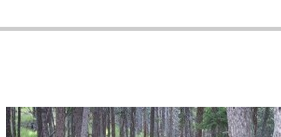
