### Resident Sammy Achterberg "Goes for Gold" in the Tokyo Olympics!

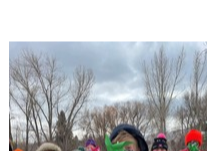

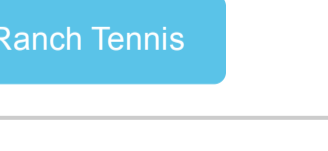

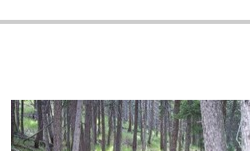
