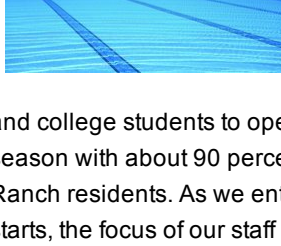

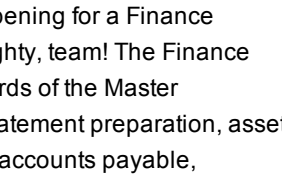
End of Summer Pool Schedule and Staffing

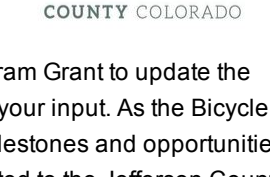

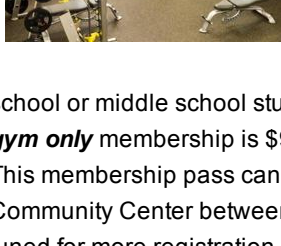
Your Input is Needed for the Jeffco Bike Plan!

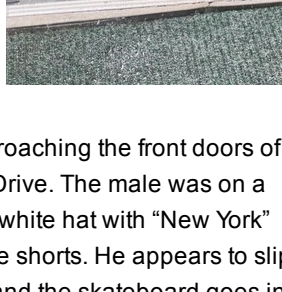
Back to School Gym Membership Deal!

KC Fitness Now Offering Barre Above and TRX!

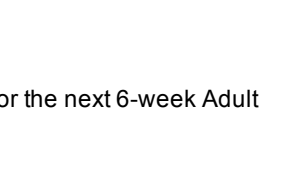

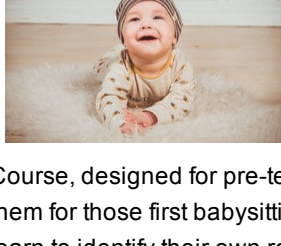

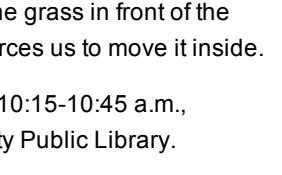


Get the Babysitting Basics in our Latest Class Offering!

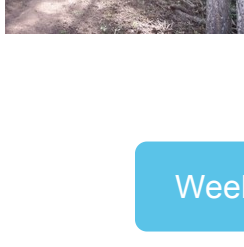
