Registration is only required for those hosting a car at the event. Registration is FREE for resident participants, \$50 for businesses.

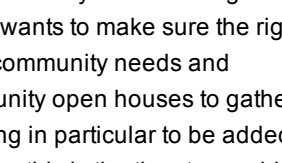
Prizes will be awarded! The best decorated patron car will win a gift basket, including season swim passes for 2022, for up to four family members (eligible for residents only).

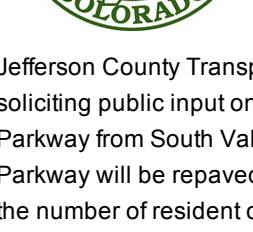
Seeking Input on New Playgrounds

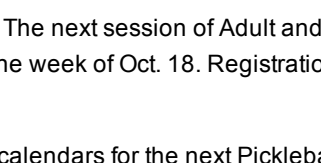


Reminder - Jeffco to Hold a Second Public Meeting About Valley Parkway Improvements

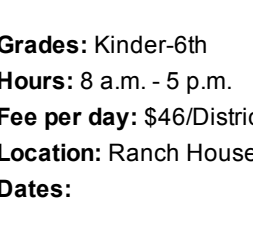
Fall Adult and Junior Tennis: The next session of Adult and Junior tennis classes begins the week of Oct. 18. Registration is now open!

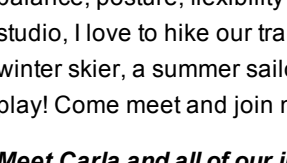
Staff Spotlight: Meet Boomer Class Instructor Cindy Briggs
