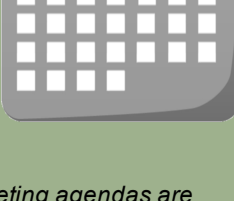

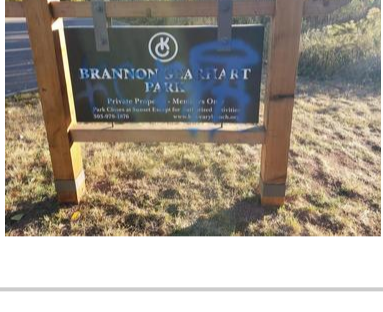
North Ranch and Brannon Gearhart: TONIGHT from 5:30-7:30 p.m. at the Community Center, 1 Club Drive

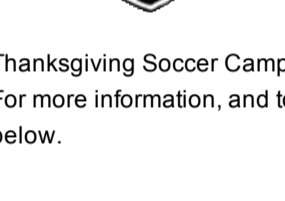

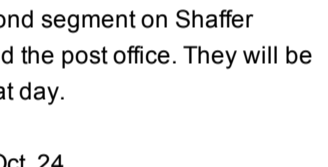

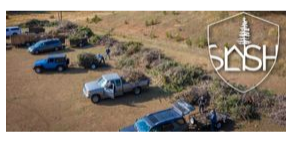
Dead Tree Removal at Disc Golf Course
