This year, there will be four seats available on the MD Board, two for a one-year term and two for a three-year term. Each registered voter may vote for four candidates.

If you are interested in running for one of the open board seats, the deadline for filing your Self-Nomination and Acceptance Form with the Designated Election Official (DEO) is Feb. 25, no later than 5 p.m. The deadline to file an affidavit of intent to be a write-in candidate with the DEO is Feb. 28, no later than 5 p.m. This year's MD Board election will take place on May 3, 2022.
