



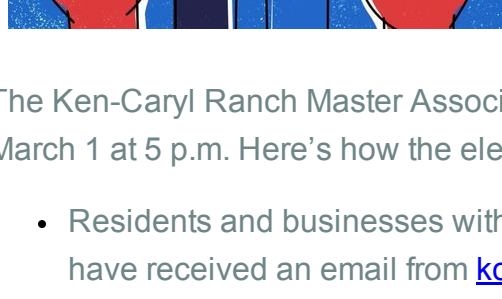

Master Association Board Election is Underway!

The Ken-Caryl Ranch Master Association Board election is currently running through March 1 at 5 p.m. Here's how the election works:

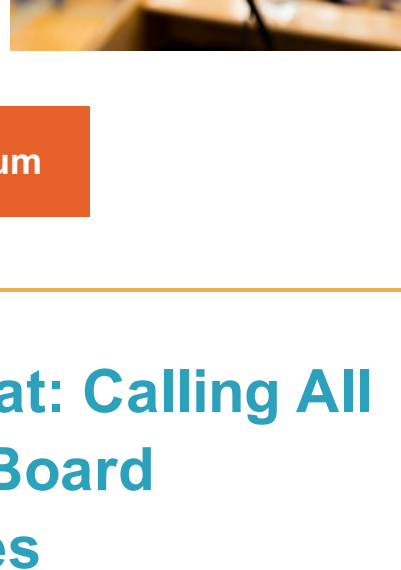
- Residents and businesses with an email address in our accounting system will have received an email from kcr@ivotehoa.com on Feb. 9 with voting instructions.
- Those residents and businesses without an email in the system will have received a postcard on or after Feb. 9.
- There is one ballot per household, or business. If you own multiple properties, or are a business, you will only vote once, but your vote will be weighted.
- The election will be done online, but paper ballots will be available at the Ranch House Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., or by appointment, for those residents who do not wish to vote online. You will need a valid photo ID to vote with a paper ballot.
- There are two open positions for the Board, so you may vote for up to two candidates. The candidate receiving the highest number of votes will fill the three-year term and the candidate receiving the second highest number of votes will fill the two-year term.

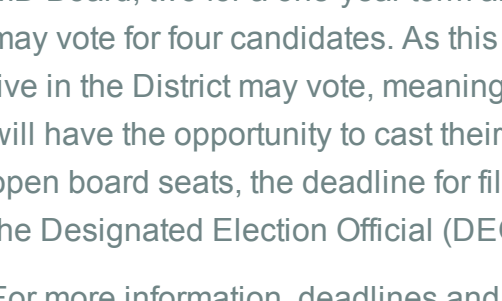

Take a Seat: Calling All 2022 MD Board Candidates

This year, there will be four seats available on the MD Board, two for a one-year term and two for a three-year term. Each registered voter may vote for four candidates. As this is a government election, all registered voters that live in the District may vote, meaning that all registered voters living in your household will have the opportunity to cast their ballot. If you are interested in running for one of the open board seats, the deadline for filing your Self-Nomination and Acceptance Form with the Designated Election Official (DEO) is Feb. 25, no later than 5 p.m.



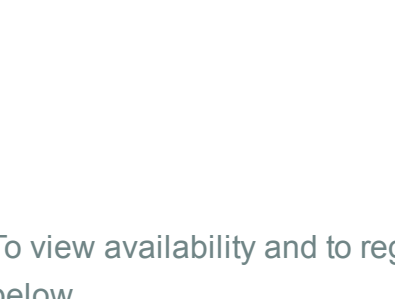

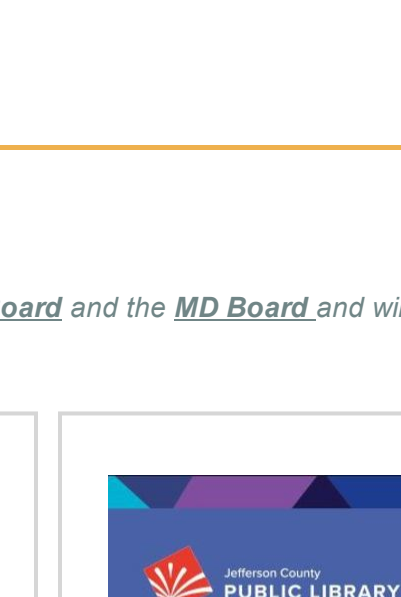

Try a FREE Spinning class Feb. 22, from 7-7:50 a.m. Due to the limited number of bikes, pre-registration is required. Register using the link below!

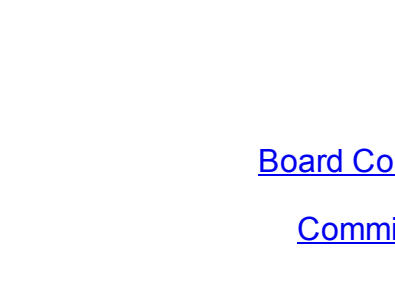

Create Defensible Space to Harden Your Home Against Wildfire

Did you know that if you live adjacent to open space, you can mow/trim up to a 10-foot swath in the open space parallel to your property boundary line to a height of no less than 4 inches? You can also remove woody vegetation up to 1 inch in diameter.

Please only work in the open space directly behind your home, or gain permission from your neighbors. This is a great way to create defensible space around your property and help protect against wildfires! Questions? Contact the Rangers at 303-979-1876, ext. 170.
