



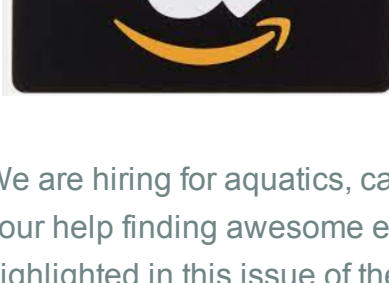

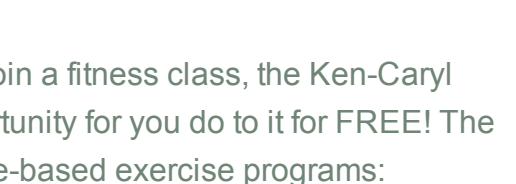
### Easter Egg Event Coming to the Ranch House

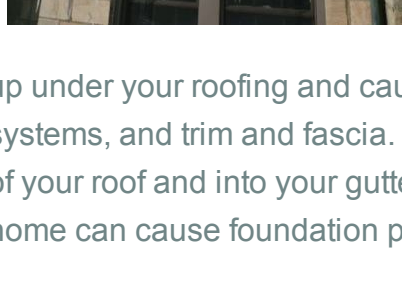

### Covenant Corner: Gutter Reminder

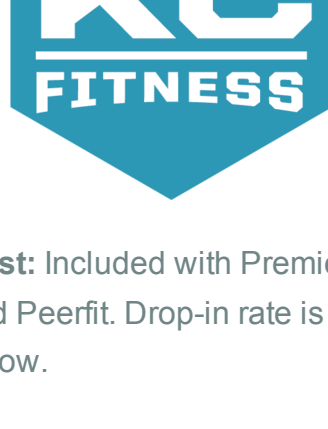
Don't forget to clean out your gutters! In the winter, clogged gutters can cause an ice dam, which can back up under your roofing and cause water damage to the substructures of your roof, gutter systems, and trim and fascia. In the warmer months, it is critical to keep water flowing off of your roof and into your gutter system. Water pooling around the foundation of your home can cause foundation problems, can rot boards and damage siding.

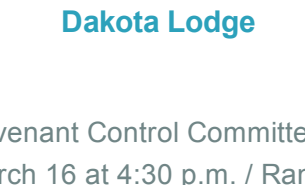

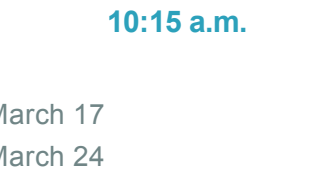
