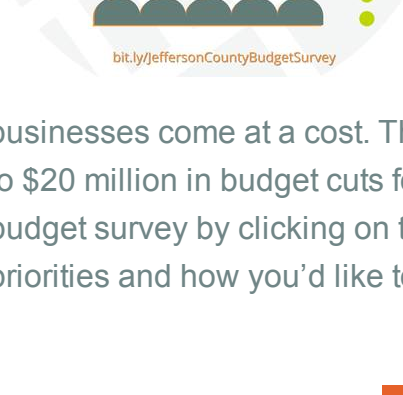
### Drop Off Your Slash!

Slash is debris, from nature, such as tree limbs and prunings (no rose stems or cacti). If not removed, slash can add to potential fire hazards on your property. Removing slash and creating a defensible space around your home is the first line of defense against wildfires.



Residents can drop off their slash at Brannon Gearhart Park on March 12 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. The Ken-Caryl Ranch Metropolitan District Parks Department will be on hand with the chipper. A limited number of curbside pickups will be offered by the Master Association Ranger staff on Thursday, March 10 and Friday, March 11. Curbside pickups must be signed up for in advance, using the button below.

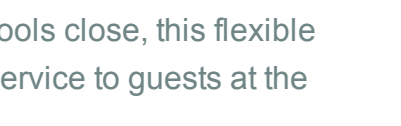


### Jefferson County Seeking Feedback on Budget Priorities

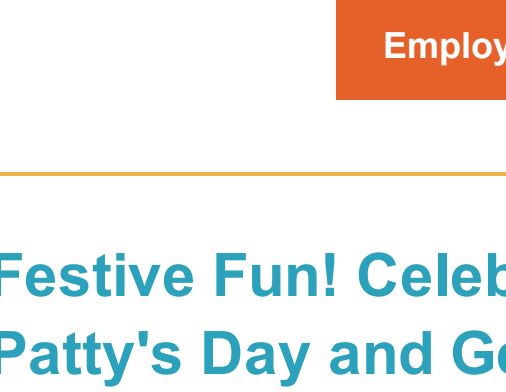
### Easter Egg Event Coming to the Ranch House

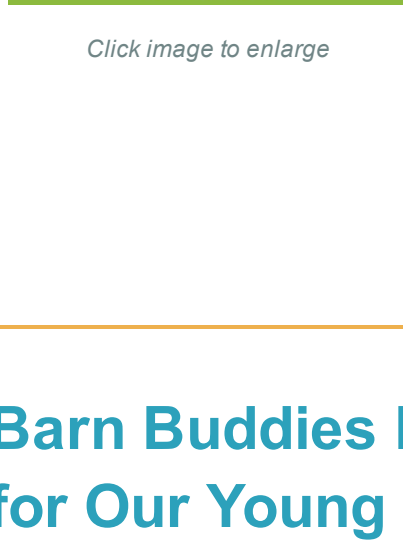
#### Learn to Dance!

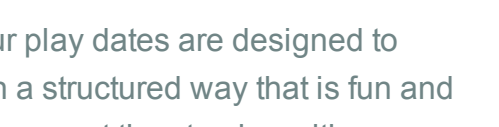
### Toddler Time Returns to the Ranch House

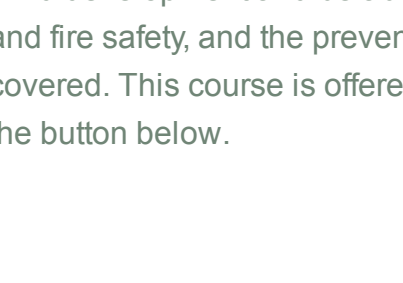
### Barn Buddies Program for Our Young Equine Enthusiasts

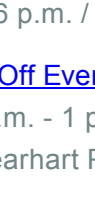
### Babysitting Clinic

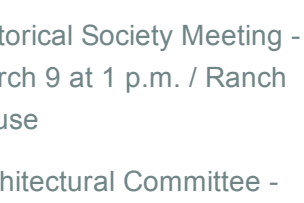
