



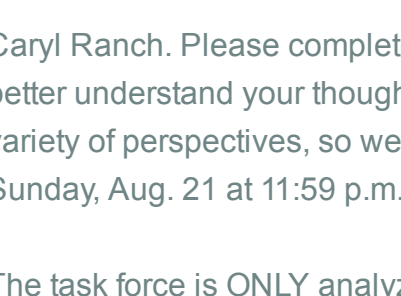

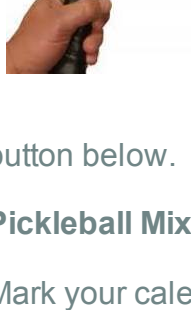
Late Season Lap Swim

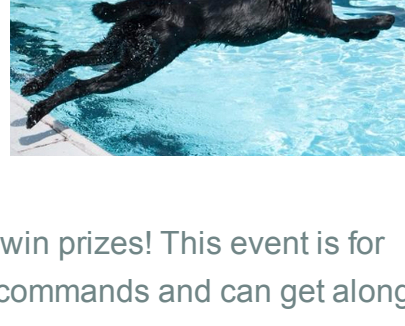

Doggie Dip Day, Aug. 20

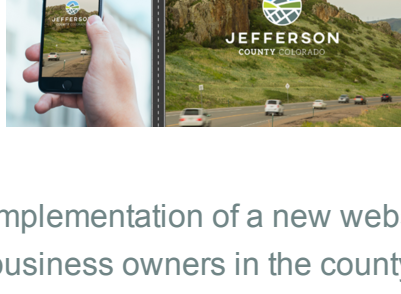

Jeffco App Allows Residents to Report Road Concerns

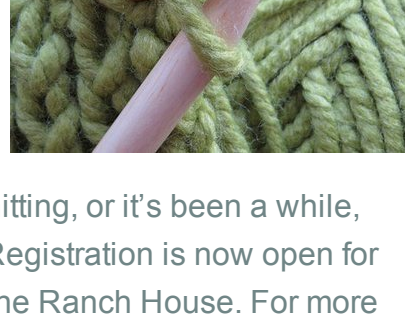

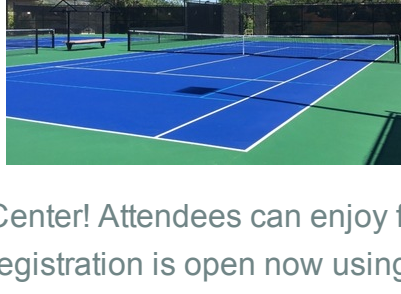

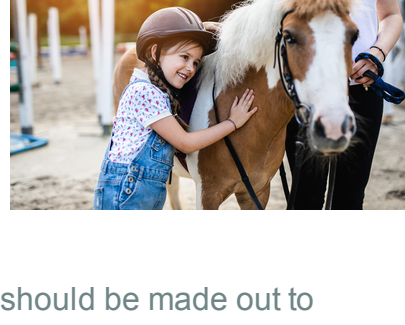
Tasty Tuesdays are Extended Through August!
