





**Tree Removal Begins in November** 

The Parks Department, along with the assistance of a tree removal contractor, will be out and about conducting tree removal services in Ken-Caryl in late November for approximately two weeks to address dead and/or dying trees in our community. As you may be aware, when Ken-Caryl Ranch was master planned decades ago,

cottonwood trees were utilized to provide a fast-growing canopy for the new community. Decades later, these trees are nearing their end of life. This, combined with the various weather events the Denver metro area has experienced over the course of the last few years, is causing significant maintenance and aesthetic issues for the community. This fall's work will help to set the stage for additional diversification and tree plantings in the


