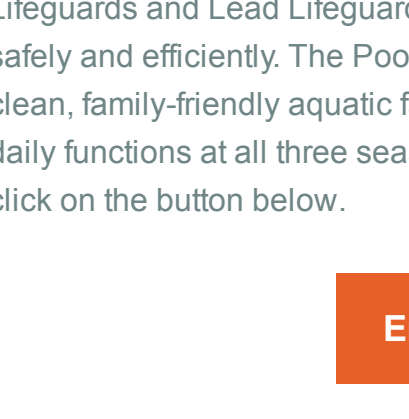
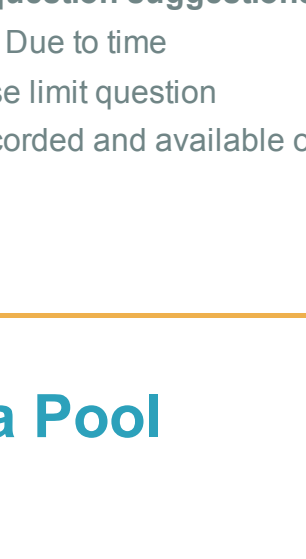
Community Park Master Plan Open House on Thursday

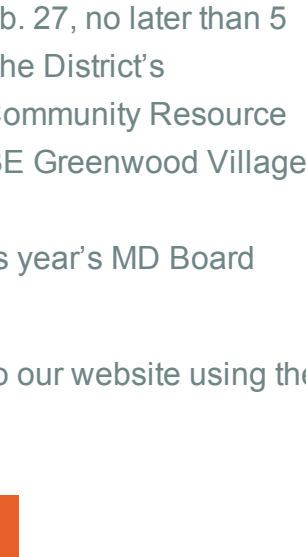

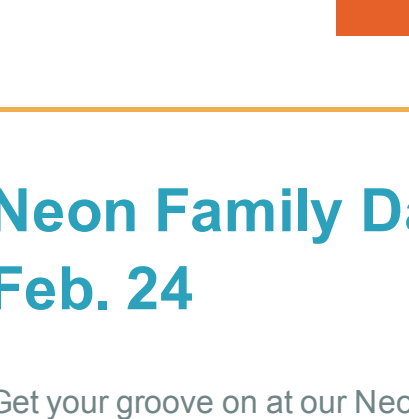
Take a Seat: Calling All 2023 MD Board Candidates!

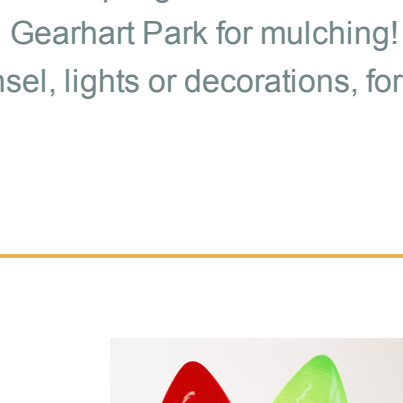

Neon Family Dance Party, Feb. 24

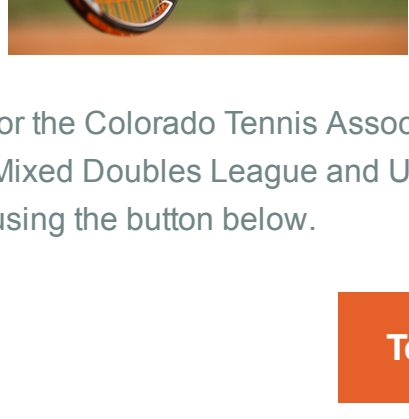

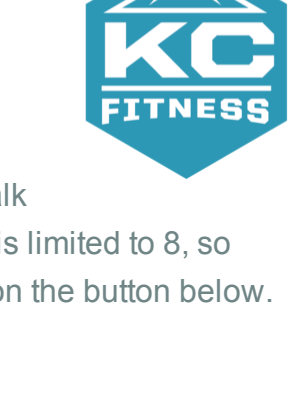


Recycle Your Christmas Tree!

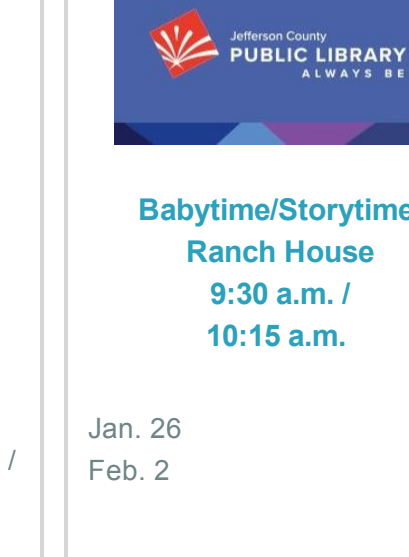
NEW Course: The Grandlore Guided Memoir Program

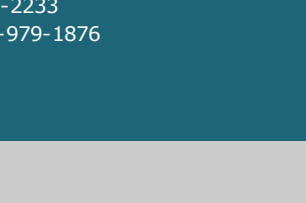
