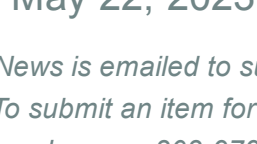

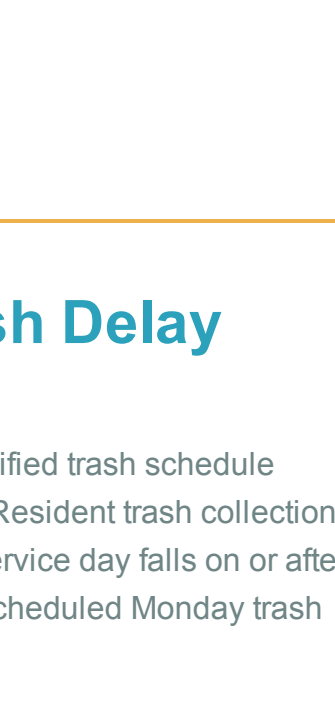

Bradford Pool: 10 a.m. – 6 p.m.

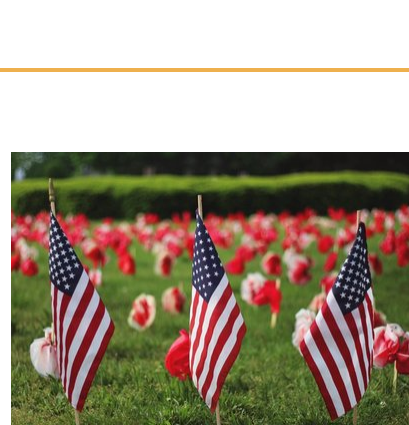

All Pools Open May 27! Have You Registered for Your FREE Pool Passes?

In-District residents are FREE; however, residents MUST register for a pool pass through their ActiveNet account prior to visiting the pools. In-District residents will be subject to pay the out-of-District rate of \$10/person if they do not register for a pool pass.

PLEASE NOTE that staff will not be able to register residents for pool passes at any of our pools, so be sure to get passes for all household members via your ActiveNet account by clicking on the button below. Registration will be reviewed by our Guest Services staff to ensure all registrants are in-District residents.

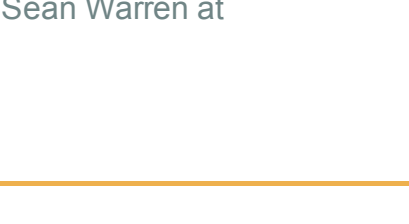

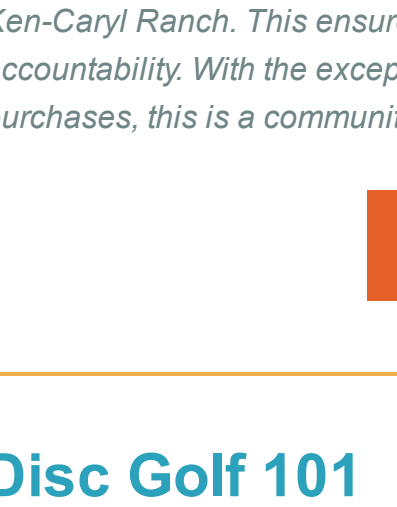
Territory Park Playground Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

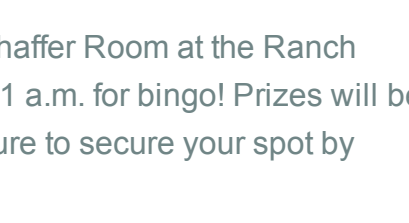
Your Concession Cravings Covered with Food Trucks at the Pool

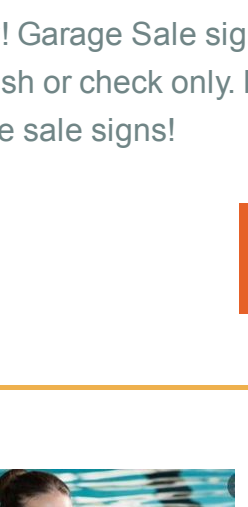

Brannon Gearhart Pond Dredging Work in Progress



Work began last week to dredge the Brannon Gearhart Pond of excess sediment. This project aims to improve the depth of the pond to deter algae growth in the summer and ready the pond for potential storm threats in the future. The accumulation of excess sediment can result in stagnant water that raises the internal temperature of the pond and increases the likelihood of algae growth. Tasty Tuesdays Returns to the Ranch House on June 6

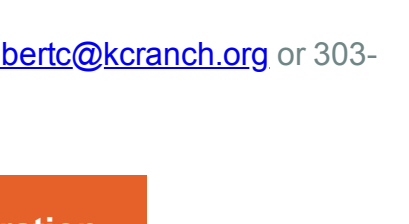

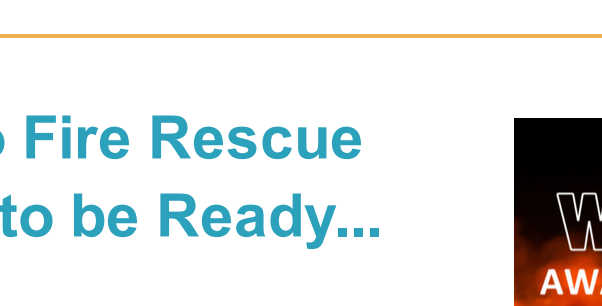


B-I-N-G-O at the Ranch House on June 10

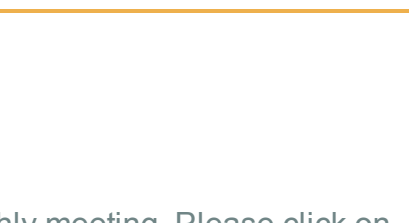

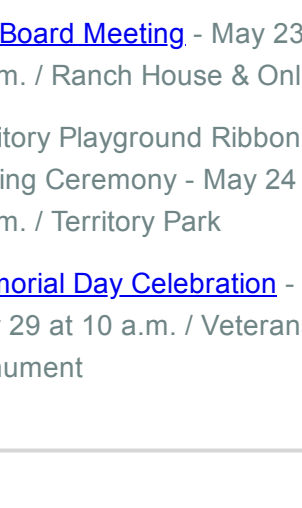
