Frequently Asked Questions

Summer Camps

★ What camps should I register my children into according to their age/grade level?:

Community Center: Preschool Camps

Rainbow Fish camp- Ages 3, 4 and 5 (must be 3 by first day of 2024 camps & fully potty trained)

Ranch House: School-Age Camps (recreation based)

Hoots camp- entering Kinder and 1st grade in the 2024/2025 school year (must be 5 years old)

Bears camp- entering 2nd and 3rd grade in the 2024/2025 school year

Lions camp- entering 4th to 6th grade in the 2024/2025 school year

Dakota Lodge: School-Age Camps (nature-outdoor education based)

Tadpoles camp- entering Kinder to 2nd grade in the 2024/2025 school year

Frogs camp- entering 3rd to 6th grade in the 2024/2025 school year

★ I have a 5-year-old going into Kindergarten next school year. Should I register them for the pre-school or school-age camp?

The biggest difference between these camps is the pace. The overall pace of the school-age camp is considered much faster than the pre-school camps. We recommend if your child is going into Kindergarten for the upcoming school year to sign up for the school-age camp. Another difference between the two is the length of camp time is. The pre-school camp hours are 8:30-1:30, the school-age camp hours are 8am-5pm.

★ Is there a 'priority status' camp registration?

We no longer offer priority status for our programs. Camp registration has 2 phases: KCR residents and non-residents.

★ Are there other camp options other than the traditional camps?

Yes! KCR hosts several sports camps and other enrichment camps every summer. To see what school-age enrichment camps that will be offered, check-in on the website [here](#). ★ I have a pre-teen/teenager. Does KCR offer camps for this age group?

Yes! The teen camps KCR offers are geared toward students ranging from 6th grade to 10th. The camps offered are one to two-week long camps with a specific focus. Such as: rock climbing, leadership, counselor-in-training, and adventure camps. These camp offerings will be updated online [here](#).

★ What are the summer camp hours?

School-age camps: Hours of camp are 8:00am to 5:00pm, drop-off between 8-9am and pick-up between 4-5pm

Pre-school camps: Hours of camp are 8:30am to 1:30pm, drop-off between 8:30-9am and pick-up between 1-1:30pm

*Any drop-offs and pick-ups outside of this must be communicated to the camp staff prior

★ Why are pre-school hours differing from the school-age camps?

Due to the active nature of camp, early childhood age appropriateness, and feedback we have determined these hours will provide the most successful environment for the participants and the staff.

★ When will the field trip schedules be posted online?

We will have each camp's field trip schedule posted online by end of day March 10, 2024.

★ Are camp swim lessons offered during summer camp hours?
